DAY 1 & 2

NAIROBI, THE EMAKOKO



On arrival into Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you will be met by a Choose Safari representative who will transfer you to the Deluxe Lodge – The Emakoko. Accommodation is booked for 2 nights on a full board basis.

In a serene and informal atmosphere, you can escape the stress of everyday life and relax, while enjoying a superb start to your safari in a unique wildlife environment. The Nairobi National Park is a wonderful refuge from Nairobi's dynamic and vibrant city centre. The park is rich in a huge number of wildlife species and unique in being a natural wildlife habitat next to a capital city. The Emakoko is a family-owned and run lodge artfully built into the side of a valley on the Mbagathi River, which borders the Nairobi National Park. The Emakoko is a 45 minute transfer from both the international and domestic airports. At times the silence can be almost deafening during the day, and the nights are often filled with distant noises of wild animals going about their nocturnal activities. The lodge offers day excursions in the National Park and too many other places of interest.

DAY 3, 4, & 5

LEWA WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY, LEWA HOUSE



After the breakfast you will be collected from The Emakoko and transferred to Wilson Airport to catch the scheduled flight to Lewa Wildlife Conservancy. On arrival into Lewa you will be met at the airstrip and transferred to Lewa House. Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on a full board basis.

Located at the very heart of the Lewa Wildlife Conservancy, the house is set on top of a hill with extensive views over gentle rolling hills with Mount Kenya to the south and the rugged Mathews Range and the sacred

mountain of Ol Olokwe to the north. Beautiful shaded gardens surround the house and breakfast or lunch is often served on the lawn. The house also has a large swimming pool which overlooks a waterhole providing some of the best game viewing on Lewa! However, our wish is that you spend as little time at the house as possible! Being on safari is all about being out in the bush watching game, appreciating how conservation of rare species works, understanding the challenges for communities living nearby and savouring this ancient and diverse environment.

DAY 6, 7, & 8

LOISABA, SABUK LODGE



After the breakfast you will be collected from the Lewa House and transferred to Airstrip to fly to Loisaba. On arrival into Loisaba you will be met at the airstrip and transferred to Sabuk Lodge. Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on a full board basis.

Sabuk Lodge set in a 600 hectares wildlife conservancy

is home to a variety of rare animals including dik-dik, giraffe, zebra, leopard, elephant and the antelope. Some of the activities you can enjoy at Sabuk Lodge are; guided camel safaris, day and night game drives, culture and safari walks, fishing, rock and artefacts hunting, bird watching, horse riding and photography. All the rooms are built of stone, wood and thatch- very much in keeping with the landscape, but also very comfortable, and with fabulous views even from the baths of most rooms! Highly trained chefs prepare mouth-watering dishes, which will leave you craving for more. Walk with a professional safari guide and a team of trained Maasai warriors as your guides through completely deserted tracts of wilderness: no other tourists, no roads or vehicles, only wildlife and their tracks, breath-taking scenery, the sounds of the bush, just Africa.



After the breakfast you will be collected from Sarara Tented Camp and transferred to the Airstrip to fly to Maasai Mara. On arrival into Maasai Mara you will be met at the airstrip and transferred to Acacia House. Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on a full board basis.

The private bush home, Acacia House sits in the Ol Chorro Losoit valley within the Lemek hills, far from the tourist trail and within the 70,000 acre Mara North Conservancy area from where the Nomadic Encounters

team have operated their wilderness expeditions for more than twenty years. There are no other guests-- you have a small Maasai staff all to yourself, and a 4X4 (with expert guide) is at your disposal around the clock. It's tucked away deep in the bush, and your nearest neighbors are miles away. To the side of the house, raised above the waterhole, there is a pool and a barbecue area which provide a place to relax, dine and socialise between safari expeditions, particularly around sunset. This pool is shared with nearby Mara House.

Wake up at dawn for your last early morning game drive in this fantastic reserve. After a delicious breakfast we will transfer you to the airstrip for your morning /

afternoon flight to Nairobi. On arrival you will be transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your international or onward flight.
