NAIROBI – OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY – MAASAI MARA – NAIROBI

From the slopes of the lush green Mount Kenya to the centre stage of nature's most dramatic arena in the Maasai Mara, experience the classic African Safari.

Day 1	Arrive Nairobi, Kenya transfer to The Koppie House, Manzoni – 2 nights
Day 3	Fly to Ol Pejeta Conservancy, Sweetwaters Tented Camp – 2 nights
Day 5	Fly to Maasai Mara, Mara Serena Safari Lodge – 2 nights
Day 7	Fly to Nairobi, transfer to JKIA, for flight back home

DAY 1 & 2

NAIROBI, THE KOPPIE HOUSE



On arrival into Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you will be met by a Choose Safari representative who will transfer you to the magnificent “place of tranquillity” – The Koppie House. Accommodation is booked for 2 nights on a full board basis.

The Koppie House on top of a hill has brilliant views across the whole region. Here you will get the first African feeling and you will leave a piece of your heart and soul in this place when you leave.



After breakfast in the Koppie House you will be collected and transferred to Wilson Airport to catch the Safarilink scheduled flight to Nanyuki which departs at 10h20. On arrival into Nanyuki you will be met at the airstrip and transferred to Sweetwaters Tented Camp. Accommodation is booked for 2 nights on a full board basis.

A sheltered oasis, clustered around a water hole, and standing within the seclusion of its own private reserve, the Ol Pejeta Conservancy, Sweetwaters Tented Camp offers a charming blend of under-canvas ambiance and uncompromising luxury. Located on the plains of Mount Kenya, the camp features a semi-circle of luxuriously appointed tents, each with a veranda overlooking the watering hole. The conservancy, which has a higher wildlife-to-area ratio than any Kenyan national park, also offers the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa, the only chimpanzee sanctuary in

Kenya, and shelters large numbers of rare and endangered species. The camp offers unprecedented opportunities for wildlife watching, either by guided walks, camel treks, or by day and night game drives.





After breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip for the Safarilink scheduled flight to the Maasai Mara departing at 09h10. You will be met at Mara North Airstrip and transferred to Mara Serena Safari Lodge. Accommodation is booked for 2 nights on a full board basis.

Mara Serena Safari Lodge. Perched on the crest of a hill, the Mara Serena Safari Lodge has one of the most spectacular views imaginable across the vast plains, forests and rivers that make up the Maasai Mara – one of the world's richest wildlife sanctuaries. It is on this very terrain that the annual migration takes place when millions of zebra, wildebeest and gazelle cross the plains below, on their way to the rich

new grasses of the Serengeti. This is a spectacle that should be witnessed at least once in a lifetime. (End of July/August is an ideal time to witness the spectacle, though timings may vary depending on the rains). The lodge has been designed to mirror a traditional Maasai village or Manyatta and all the guest rooms are located in individual domed huts grouped in a circular manner. The furnishings of each room have been inspired by traditional Maasai art and each one has a private balcony with views that stretch over the vast African landscape.

Certainly the most frequented game reserve in Kenya, Maasai Mara is a magnificent landscape of open plains bisected by the Mara River and its tributaries, and punctuated by marshes and forests. The reserve is home to all the "big five" and it is also possible to observe; baboon, eland, ostrich, bat-eared fox, jackal, cheetah, and the rivers abound with hippos and crocodiles. The Mara is also noted for its abundance of lions- particularly the superb black maned males. You'll see elephants here, often in large herds, as well as- if you're lucky- leopard, cheetah and rhino. Get the cameras ready, stock up on film and enjoy yourself!

After a last game drive in the Masai Mara, at 10h00 you will be transferred to the airstrip to catch the 11h00 Safarilink flight back to Nairobi. Arriving at

12h15, a Choose Safari representative will meet and transfer you to the international airport for your journey home.
